OCR's A Level in Latin is designed to help students further develop their understanding of the Latin language and the related ancient literature, values and society. Most of the grammar has been covered at GCSE but is assessed in more complex and sophisticated forms. The subject is not topic based but comprises all aspects of grammar throughout. Students will develop their knowledge of vocabulary, morphology and syntax in order to read, understand and interpret Latin. They will be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the historical, literary and cultural context of a text to identify and appreciate its literary form and impact on the reader and to evaluate evidence from a range of sources.

It is intended that students will develop insights into the relevance of Latin and of ancient literature and civilisation to our understanding of our modern world of diverse cultures. Students will also be able to deploy their knowledge and understanding of Latin to deepen their understanding of English and other modern and ancient languages. Students will be able to relate their knowledge and understanding of the ancient world to a diverse range of disciplines, such as literature, history, philosophy, and develop an understanding of the origins of many types of scientific and legal terminology

We hope that Latin will offer our students the opportunity to develop research and analytical skills which will empower them to become independent learners and enquirers, equipping them for further study in arts, humanities and sciences.
